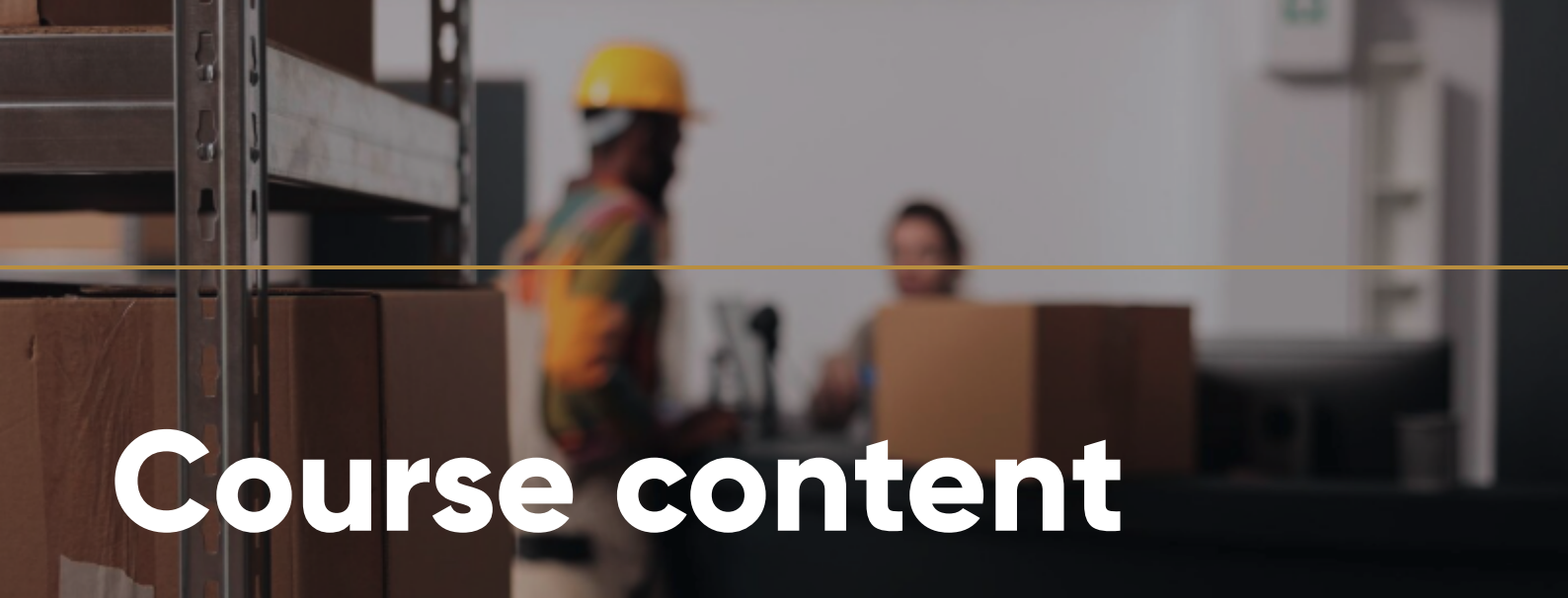
# Effective Store Management and Stock Control

## Course Methodology

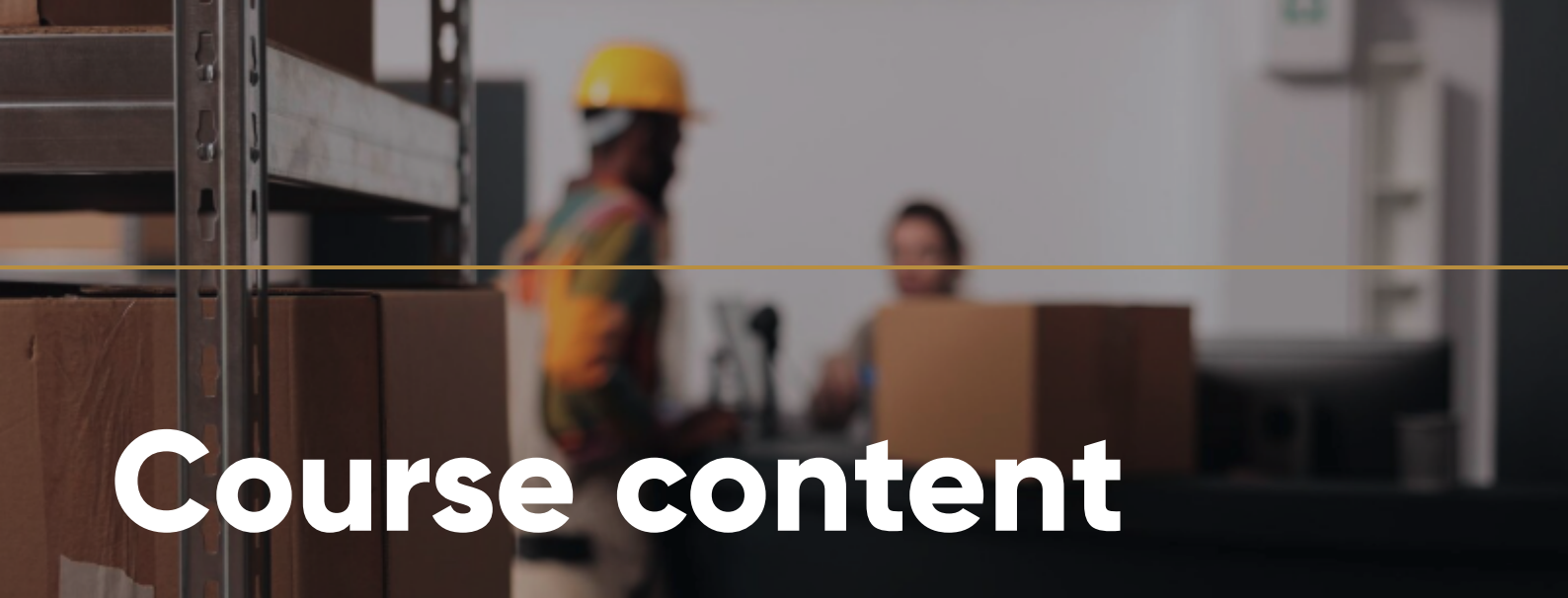

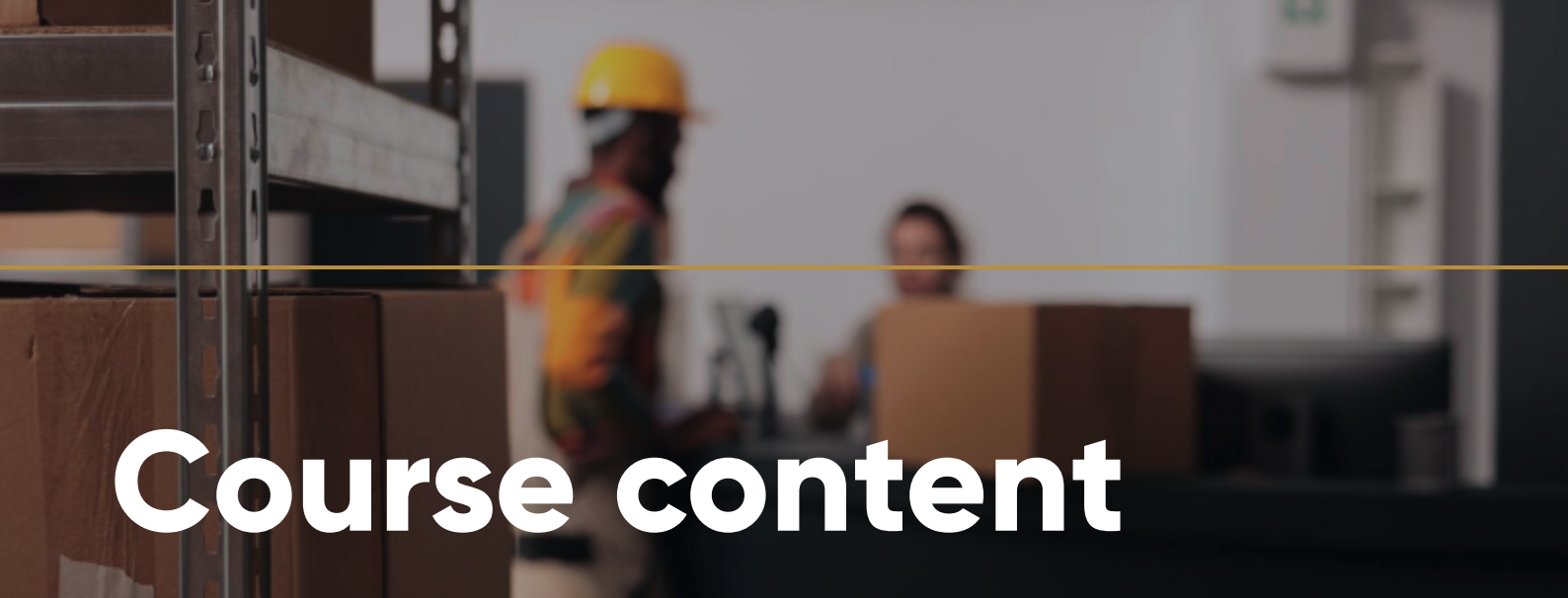

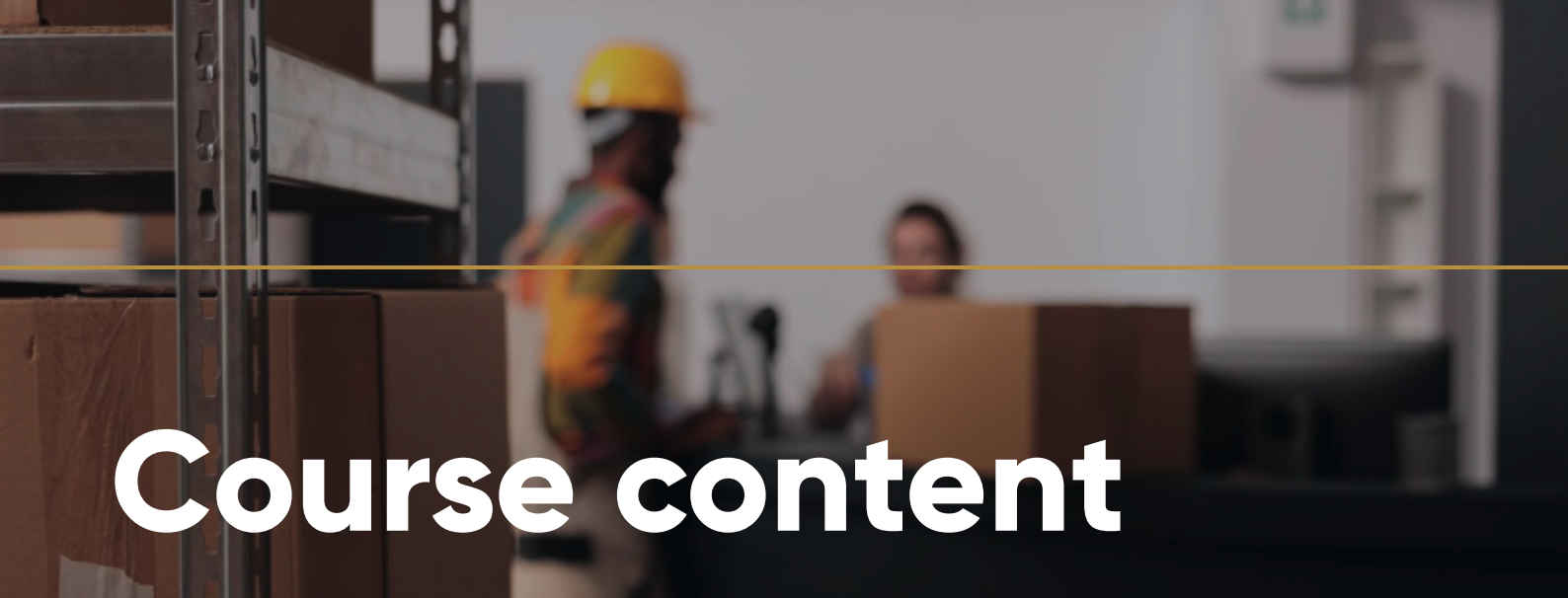
